Mariner Write does support the copying and pasting of formats. In fact, we always copy the formatting and other info, you decide what you want to paste.

## To copy formatting:

- 1. Copy text by selecting the Edit>Copy command or the by using the keyboard shortcut Cmd-C.
- 2. Select text that you would like to paste the formatting onto.
- 3. Go to the Edit Menu and Select "Edit Special>Paste Style".

Now lets make this even easier by assigning Paste Style a keyboard shortcut like Option+Cmd+V.

## To paste formatting:

- 1. Go to the Preferences menu to the "Keys" Tab.
- 2. Select "Edit Special" from the "Menu:" pop-down list.
- 3. Double-click "Edit Special" from the resulting pane.
- 4. Press "option + Cmd + v".
- 5. Click OK.
