## How to configure Paperless to import from a ScanSnap scanner

You can configure Paperless to import from a ScanSnap scanner by following these steps:

- 1. Make sure that ScanSnap Manager is running.
  - If ScanSnap Manager is not yet installed on your Mac, please refer to documentation provided with your scanner by Fujitsu.
- Make sure that the scanner is connected to the Mac, powered on, and ready to scan.
  If the scanner is ready to scan, ScanSnap Manager should display a notification that the scanner is ready.
- 3. In Paperless, display Paperless preferences. Under the scanner section make sure that the preference **Use ScanSnap scanner** is selected.
  - You should only need confirm this setting the first time you import from a ScanSnap scanner.
- 4. Once the document is loaded into the document feeder on the scanner, click either the **Scan** or **Scan Multi** button in the Paperless toolbar, to start the scan process.

ScanSnap Manager should now execute the scan process, and Paperless should import the completed scan into your Paperless library.
