In this case, the font "Bauhaus93" is corrupt. You may have a corrupt font that is causing the messages. To mitigate this situation please launch FontBook and run the validation on all your fonts. Backstory, Mariner Write has a WYSIWYG font menu and we ask the system to draw each font for us - if a font is corrupt it causes the process to fail and crash.
