If Paperless prompted me to restart Safari after I enabled the Safari toolbar button in preferences, why hasn't Safari restarted yet?

If Safari is running while the Safari toolbar option is enabled in Paperless preferences, Safari will need to be restarted in order to use the Paperless button with Safari. You will be prompted twice to restart Safari:

- 1. Once by Paperless. Paperless will prompt you to restart Safari.
- 2. Once by Safari. Safari will prompt you that it has been instructed to restart.

If either of these prompts are cancelled, Safari will remain open, and the import to Paperless button will not show. Safari can be restarted manually by quitting the application, then launching it again.
