Which types of files can I open with Narrator?

Currently, the following types of files can be opened by Narrator:

- **Plain Text Files** (word-processor files with extension .TXT)
- **Rich Text Files** (word-processor files with extension .RTF)
- **Microsoft Word Files** (word-processor files with extension .DOC)
- **HTML Files** (Web-page files with extensions .HTML, .HTM, etc.)

Opening files with Narrator is just like opening a file with any other program: either select **Open with** in the file's contextual menu (option-clicking the file icon) or choosing **File > Open...**

It is also possible to paste text into Narrator from any of a variety of sources, including Web browsers or any other program that allows for selecting and copying text. Narrator will attempt to preserve the formatting of pre-formatted text pasted into a Narrator document from another source.
