Why does Montage move from Dialogue back to Character (instead of Action) when I hit the return key?

When typing in any element in Montage, hitting the return key will take you to the "Next Element." The Next Element can be changed to reflect your own preference. To change the Next Element, simply select Document Properties from the File menu. In Document Properties, click on any element in the left column, then choose whichever element you would like to set as the Next Element from the appropriate popup list. In the above example, changing the Next Element for Dialogue from Character to Action, will cause Montage to move from Action to Dialogue when you type the return key.

Note that the default Next Element for each element may differ depending on which Template you use to create your document.
